Inspired by EPI M1000 quadratic tower speaker. A tall square cross-section tower with a Pluvia 11 on each vertical face. Forms quadrapole source with each P11 run fullrange.

Requires free-space positioning with at least 4 feet/1.3m to any from walls for proper functioning.

- 0/ drawn with 18mm material. Quality plywood recommended
- 1/ for 4 x Mark Audio Pluvia 11
- 2/ line all interior faces with damping material: SAE F10 felt, Ultratouch, acoustic fiberglass, or similar
- 3/ don't forget to relieve the back of the driver cutout with a chamfer or roundover
- 4/ bracing not shown but recommended. Braces should run in the direction of the line
- 5/ beveling front vertical edges recommended
- 6/ stabilizing plinth recommended
- 7/ wire drivers in series/parallel
